FLEET HOSPITAL FIELD TRAINING (FHFT)

An eight (8) day course conducted at FHOTC. Target audience-Core billets assigned to Fleet Hospitals including medical, non-medical, and Seabee personnel. Class size-Approximately 200-280 personnel assigned to hosting Fleet Hospital command. Provides an orientation to the assembly, operation and disassembly of a Navy Fleet Hospital; includes an operational casualty exercise.

49 Continuing Medical Education Units (CMEs) and/or 23 Continuing Education Units (CEUs) are currently offered through the Fleet Hospital Field Training (FHFT) course to all healthcare providers (Physicians, Registered Nurses, Physician Assistants, Paramedics, Emergency Medical Technicians and Hospital Corpsman). Those wishing to receive CEUs must remember to bring their licensure and/or certification documentation to this course in order to receive the CEUs.

OXYGEN GENERATOR TRAINING

Provides basic training on the operation, repair, and maintenance techniques of the Oxygen Generators unique to the Fleet Hospitals.

ALL ACTIVE DUTY AND RESERVE PERSONNEL QUOTAS MUST BE OBTAINED FROM THE FHOTC TRAINING OFFICER AT LEAST ONE MONTH PRIOR TO THE CONVENING DATE.
