

HMCS (SW/FMF) MARVIN L. BAILEY

Senior Chief Bailey was born in Pontiac, Michigan on October 29, 1959. He graduated from Lapeer West Senior High in 1978. He enlisted in the Navy in July 1982 and attended basic training at Recruit Training Center, San Diego, California. He attended Basic Hospital Corps School at Naval School of Health Sciences, San Diego, California and served at Naval Hospital, San Diego until 1984.

Upon completion of his initial assignment, he attended Field Medical Service School, Camp Pendleton, California and was subsequently assigned to 1st Marine Division, Camp Pendleton, California from 1984 to 1988. Petty Officer Bailey completed a successful six-month deployment in the unit deployment program with 1st Battalion 7th Marines during this tour. Additionally, he was advanced to Petty Officer Second Class through the Command Advancement Program and awarded his first Navy Achievement Medal.

HM2 Bailey's next assignment was the Naval School of Health Sciences, San Diego, California where he served from 1988 to 1992 and advanced to Petty Officer First Class. From 1992 to 1994, HM1 Bailey served as the Leading Petty Officer and Senior Enlisted Advisor for Fleet Surgical Team One. He completed a Western Pacific deployment onboard the USS NEW ORLEANS and RIMPAC onboard the USS ESSEX. HM1 Bailey earned his Surface Warfare designation and was promoted to Chief Petty Officer during this tour of duty.

In November 1994, he reported to Inspector-Instructor Staff, 4th Medical Battalion where he served as the Command Chief until 1999. In January 1999, Chief Bailey reported to 1st Marine Division, Camp Pendleton, California and served as the Senior Medical Department Representative with 3rd Battalion, 5th Marines and was advanced to Senior Chief Petty Officer in September 2001. He then served as the Regimental Senior Chief, 5th Marine Regiment. He assumed his current position as Command Senior Chief, Fleet Hospital Operations and Training Command on January 22, 2002.

Senior Chief Bailey holds a Bachelor of Business Administration from National University and a Master of Business Administration from California State University San Marcos.

He has earned Surface Warfare and Fleet Marine Forces Specialist qualifications. His personal awards include the Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medal and Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal with three Gold Stars.
